GO GREEN! You may notice that we have changed the look of the Pointer a bit in this edition. We did so to recognize and honor the fantastic work and achievements of the Peninsula Point CERT.

Over the past 18 months, the Peninsula Point CERT has: developed an awareness program, deployed block captains, provided training, aggregated and disbursed emergency supplies to residents as requested, established a Command Post at the Bay Beach and has stocked the post with emergency supplies including a defibrillator. All of this has been done on behalf of the

neighborhood to assist in the event that we are struck by a major disaster and emergency personnel are unable to respond in a timely manner.

As a direct result of these efforts, on Wednesday, January 24^{th} , the Peninsula Point CERT was recognized as the **CERT Neighborhood of the Year** by the Newport Beach Fire Department.


Did you know?



Newport Harbor High School, Hall of Fame Honorees Spotlighted

On May 25th, **Tod White**, a graduate of Newport Harbor High School, and a past **BPPA President**, will be inducted into the school's Hall of Fame. Tod (class of 1955) set a national high school record his senior year by running a four minute, twenty second mile in the Southern California CIF finals at the Los Angeles Coliseum. That record lasted for six years.

At Occidental College, Tod was part of the 2-mile relay team that broke a world record. Tod's best time ever in the mile came at Occidental - *clocking in at 4:08!*
