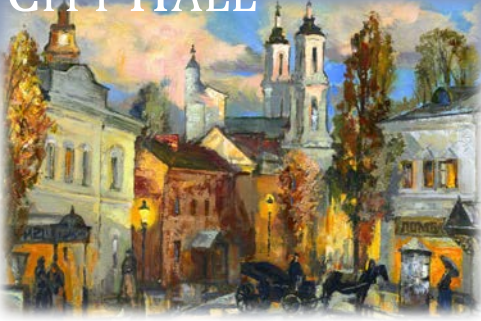
BOARD MEETINGS

Expansion of the Boardwalk Bike Path?

The March 2017 BPPA board meeting was livelier than is typical. Many in our community showed up to discuss with Councilwoman and former Mayor Diane Dixon, the idea of expanding the boardwalk from E Street to G Street.

As some have recently heard, there has been discussions at Newport Beach City Hall, regarding concerns associated with the bike path including: the use of surreys, the speed of some users of e-bikes, overall congestion as well as the configuration of the end of the bike path at E Street.

Dixon stated that no decisions have been made regarding the bike path and that all dialogue at the city is in very preliminary stages. Dixon requested that interested members of the community express their position via email to the city offices and or by attending city meetings. COMMUNITY EMERGENCY RESPONSE TEAM

On Saturday, April 29, the Newport Beach Fire Department will hold a CERT Neighborhood Drill for Newport Beach neighborhoods. The drill will begin at 9:00 AM. The purpose of the drill is to simulate a disaster and to implement the emergency plan that has been established for your neighborhood.



The Peninsula Point CERT team will set up a command post at “L” Street Park. Block captains will meet at the park at 9:00am, receive their assignments and begin to systematically check the blocks for which they are responsible. The block captains will report any “incidents” to the staff at the command center.

The drill will last approximately one hour.

Information regarding the CERT program will be available at the “L” Street Park command post. Please feel free to stop by to learn how you can prepare for and participate in your community disaster program.
