FOUNDATION ACTIVITIES

The Community Foundation of Balboa Peninsula Point (CFBPP) continues to accept tax-deductible donations to support qualifying worthwhile projects in our community. The summer security patrol program (managed by BPPA) has been one of our most popular programs and, with your continued support, we plan to fund it again this year.

Another popular project, the small Tot Lot at Miramar and Balboa Blvd., was approved by City Council at their December 2012 Meeting. An Encroachment Agreement with BPPA has since been executed and we are ready to begin. CFBPP will fund the entire project. If all goes well, the facility should be completed and available for use this summer. Great thanks to Paul McKelvey for all of his coordination work with the City and his willingness to provide pro bono management of the project.

The Foundation is currently in discussions with a well-respected wall mural artist to put an historical mural on the wall of a prominent Balboa Village building wall. It is too early to present details, but we will keep you advised of status as the project matures.

Thanks to all Foundation contributors for your continuing support of these quality-of-life improvement projects in our community.

Street Improvements

The repaving of the Balboa and Channel Roads within our neighborhood will start this March. The City plans to repave the streets that were affected by the underground utility work done over the past few months. These streets will be repaved first before summer traffic impacts our neighborhood. Residents being affected by this work will be notified in advanced by the City.
