

BPPA BAY BEACH RULES

PLEASE BE RESPECTFULL OF THE COMMUNITY AND THOUGHTFUL OF THOSE WHO SHARE THE BEACH WITH YOU. WE ARE VERY FORTUNATE TO HAVE THE USE OF THE BAY BEACH. REMEMBER IT IS A PRIVELIDGE WE HAVE NOT A RIGHT.

- 1. Bay beach use rules shall follow the same rules as City of Newport Beach municipal code 11 recreational activities.
- 2. Hours: Closed 10p.m. to 6a.m. MC 11.08.030
- 3. Beach area cleaned, dining area should be swept and hosed off by 10p.m. Bring you own 32 gallon trash bags and put all trash bags out to curb by city trash can, do not leave trash cans full inside the gates. Clean up must be done at the end of your party, not the next day.
- 4. No private reservations on Tuesday and Friday nights from 5-10 PM, BBQ open to all members on these nights.
- 5. No Holiday Reservations BBQ open to all members.
- 6. Reservations: Only apply to the BBQ and concrete area from entry gate to the east. All sand and adjacent tables are not subject to reservation. Let reservations know if you are open to other people joining you of if you have a private function.
- 7. Members may only have one reservation on the books at a time.
- 8. 48 hour notice for reservations. If there are no reservations on the books and you want to have a spontaneous BBQ, call Ramp Chairman to get the propane unlocked. The BBQ will be open to all members that show up. If no one is around to unlock the propane feel free to bring your own BBQ down. To get BBQ unlocked you must designate a member to be responsible for cleanup.

9. Parties:

- Adult member must be present at all times.
- Adult supervision of all children must be provided at all times.
- \$250. deposit required for parties in excess of 20 people.
- Certificates of Additional Insured shall be required for parties in excess of 20 visitors. These certificates shall name the BPPA as the additional insured and come from the member's home owners insurance.
- No Porto-Potties
- No Bounce Houses-Trampolines. See muni code 11.08.010
- Bands and amplified noise: City permit required. See muni code 11.03.020. For permit info see muni code 11.03.040

10. BBQ Rules:

- \$15. usage fee (paid by check to reservations chairman, made out to BPPA. No cash)
- Please clean grill after use with tools provided.

Traffic Plan Peninsula Point

As you all know in July of last summer we had a High Surf Event that caused gridlock and parking problems on the Point. Since that event the BPPA has been working with Councilman Henn and Lt. Koudelka, NBPD to resolve the issues of that weekend. NBPD has been developing a plan to alleviate congestion on the peninsula. In March of this year the BPPA met with Lt. Koudelka and Councilman Henn to review and get our approval of the traffic plan. I'm happy to say we now have a plan in place, Balboa Peninsula Traffic Access Control Point (TACP). Here are some of the details.

- TACP will be implemented when Balboa Peninsula vehicular traffic becomes severely congested, causing a threat to public safety.
- Incoming traffic will be turned around at 15th street.
- Residents and people with specific destinations east of 15th street will be allowed beyond TACP.
- Proof of residency will need to be shown. Driver's license, car registration, water, phone bill or something similar.
- If you are off of the Peninsula and trying to get back to your house, you will need to plan for extra time. There will not be a designated lane for residents before you reach 15th street.
- Traffic signals will be synchronized to allow traffic to flow westbound freely.
- NBPD communications personnel will initiate a Special Interest Group Alert describing the event. This information will be disseminated to the media and public.
- When the threat to public safety is resolved the TACP will be removed.

We all need to remember that this was an event that we have not seen in a long time. The weather was extremely hot, the media was reporting on every radio and TV station, there was a big surf contest going on in Huntington Beach and to top it off one of the Ferrys was out of service. I urge everyone to have some patience if this happens again. The City has listened to us and they understand our concerns. They do not want this to happen again. If you would like to see the full Traffic Plan I have a copy that you are welcome to read. If you have any questions please give me a call.
