



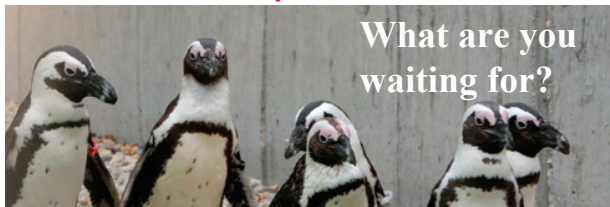
Spring is fast upon us. Membership renewal is in full swing. The Bay Beach is looking very good.

BOARDWALK SAFETY

Safety on the Ocean Front Walk is always a concern. Mike Henn, our city councilman, formed a committee of locals and city representatives to look into the issues and develop suggestions to be presented to the City Council.

I have been part of this committee. It's hard to legislate common sense, but hopefully better signage will slow down traffic and improve courtesy. The police are involved and have begun an awareness campaign so everyone knows the rules, then they will shift to more enforcement. I'm sure an "unsafe operation" ticket will make people very aware.

The most contentious issue is the Surreys and Segways. Surreys are banned from the Ocean Front Walk, but the ban is not enforced.



Motorized Segways are permitted because the State classifies the Segway as a pedestrian. But the State does give cities the right to limit the areas Segways can ride.

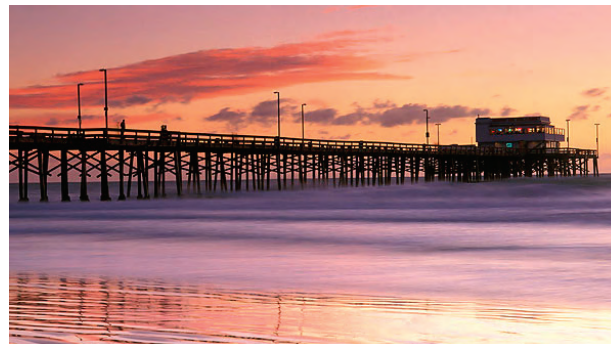
OUTGOING PRESIDENT'S LETTER
