The city has started all permits for the use of the L Street Park. A small group will meet with the city about the poor condition of the grass in the park. A new type of grass is needed because of the shade from the surrounding trees.

<u>July 4th -</u> TK Burger and an Ice Cream vender are planned for this year. A separate celebration is being planned for the 75th Anniversary of BPPA.

Foundation: Ken reported that the needed \$100,000 has been raised so that Security can be extended to year long. All the events to raise the extra money worked! This must happen yearly.
