



## **Greetings Friends and Neighbors!**

Thank you for your interest in **The Community Foundation of Balboa Peninsula Point**, or **CFBPP**. We are a **501(C) (3)** organization that supports safety, security, and neighborhood enhancements via the generous, tax-deductible donations of our supporters. We hope that you will consider contributing to the CFBPP and wanted to provide background on the organization and highlight some of the initiatives made possible by the on-going financial support of our neighbors.

### **FOUNDATION BACKGROUND:**

In 2006, the Community Foundation of Balboa Peninsula Point was established to fund projects and community initiatives that enhance the quality of life for our residents. Shortly after, CFBPP received state and Federal approval as a 501(c)(3) Charitable Foundation and moved forward on important community initiatives funded by annual tax-deductible donations from residents.

### **CFBPP BOARD:**

### **PAST PROJECTS:**

Starting in 2007, CFBPP embarked on a series of neighborhood projects, with a focus on addressing local concerns, promoting civic engagement, and advocating for community safety measures. Current and proposed projects are posted in our annual COMPASS publication.

Previous projects include:

- Speed studies on Balboa Boulevard
- The development of a Tot Lot at the corner of Miramar Drive and Balboa Boulevard
- Public art enhancements in Balboa Village
- Island landscaping refurbishments and lighting at G and I Streets

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## **PUBLIC SAFETY:**

Clearly a topic that is top-of-mind to every resident, we are proud of how the community has embraced and supported the CFBPP funded security patrol effort. Originally a seasonal/holiday proactive solution, we are now able – through generous annual donor support – to deploy **KMA Security Patrol** nightly from 7:00PM to 3:00AM on a year-round basis. KMA does continuous nightly neighborhood patrols, clears any after-hours beach activity, and has a strong working relationship with Newport Beach Police Department (NBPD) should incidents occur.

Additionally, the CFBPP funded, implemented, and annually supports a **License Plate Reader (LPR)** installation at the entrance to Peninsula Point. This is a 24/7 system which is integrated into the NBPD neighborhood security effort. To date, data from the LPR device has been used by NBPD and the Department of Homeland Security to support security investigations.

Both the **KMA Security Patrol** and the **LPR** installation contribute significantly to Peninsula Point consistently being one of the safest neighborhoods based on NBPD Neighborhood Watch crime statistics.

## **FUNDING:**
